

Frequently Asked Questions: Retreats

What is Luther Point? How do I get there?

Luther Point is a camp and retreat center affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA). We are located an hour and a half from the Twin Cities. One need not be affiliated with the ELCA, or any religious identity in order to stay here. We welcome all to come and retreat at our beautiful facility on Big Wood Lake

What is your maximum capacity?

Our maximum capacity varies depending on what building you rent.

Retreat Center: 48 beds

Luther Lodge: 20 beds

Trinity: 10 beds

Family Cabins

Galilee-6 beds

Jericho- 6 beds

Zion- 4 beds

Jerusalem (large studio)- 6 beds

Nazareth (studio) 2 beds

Do you offer linens?

We offer linens at a price of \$7.50 per person

What is the check in and check out time?

These times are much more flexible during the time when summer camp is not going on. Groups typically arrive after 5:00PM , and leave by 11:00AM on Sunday. Different arrangements are able to be made when camp is not in session. Please call the office regarding check in/check out times during the busy summer season.

Where do I go when I arrive?

When you arrive, go to the building that you are staying in, and a retreat host will be there to welcome you and give you more information regarding your stay. It is helpful to coordinate this with the retreat coordinator the week before.

Where do I park?

Luther Lodge/Trinity: Basketball Court

Family Cabins: In front of your cabin

Retreat Center: In the designated parking lot behind the center

May I bring my dog?

We have 2 cabins that allow dogs. We also allow service animals in every building.

Does Luther Point do weddings?
